MINUTES OF THE COMMON COUNCIL SPECIAL BUDGET MEETING
OF MARCH 9, 2015

A Special Budget meeting of the Common Council of the City of Salem was called to order by Council President Karen Roots. The meeting took place in the Municipal Building located at 1 New Market Street at 4:30 p.m. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Council President Karen Roots, Councilpersons, Ruth Carter, Earl Gage, Vaughn Groce, Charles Hassler, and James Waddington. Council President announced that a quorum was present. Also in attendance were City Solicitor David J. Puma, CFO David Crescenzi, and City Clerk Kathleen L. Keen. Mayor Washington and Councilmen Sherman Hampton and Horace Johnson were absent.

STATEMENT OF THE OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT

OLD BUSINESS:

CFO Crescenzi discussed applying for Transitional Aid and the application deadline of March 16, 2015. He explained the "CAP" and referendum needed if the city were to go that route, noting the state does not look kindly on towns under state aid, they want towns to sustain themselves. The discussion then turned to landlord licenses, CO's and non-payment of taxes; people walking away from homes and the loss of jobs within the city recently with Ardaugh closing and relocation of Wire Pro. Lastly CFO Crescenzi questioned what dollar amount applying for and the narrative for the transitional aid application.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Salem, in the County of Salem, and the State of New Jersey recognizes the need to apply for financial assistance by submission of Application under the Transitional Aid Program for the CY 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council acknowledges that upon submission of the application, State oversight shall begin immediately and will be terminated only upon one of the

following conditions: (1) the application for aid is withdrawn; (2) notice is received that no award of funds will be provided in 2015; or (3) consistent with the terms of the/an MOU are required to be executed as a condition of grant award.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Salem, in the County of Salem and State of New Jersey that the Submission of the Transitional Aid Application for the CY 2015 is hereby authorized and approved.
