

State Incentives

Angel Investor Tax Credit Program

Great for redevelopment, the tax credit program provides up to \$25 million of Angel Investor Tax Credit that can be approved per calendar year. for more information, visit https://www.njeda.com/technology_lifescience s/angel_investor_tax_credit_program

Economic Redevelopment and Growth (ERG) **Program**

Incentive grant program for reimbursement of up to 20% of total project cost for commercial projects with additional grant funding possible based on project type and/or location.

Residential projects can receive a tax credit for up to 20% of total project cost with 10% bonus possible if the project constructs and reserves at least 10% of residential units for moderate income housing. Bond Financing

Through a federally authorized program, the NJEDA issues conduit tax-exempt private activity bonds, the proceeds of which are used to provide financing. \$500,000 to \$10 million in tax credit bonds are available for for-profit companies. Grow New Jersey Assistance Program

Grow NJ is a job creation and retention incentive program that provides tax credits per employee on a yearly basis. Businesses that are creating or retaining jobs in New Jersey may be eligible for tax credits ranging from \$500 to \$5,000 per job, per year; with bonus credits ranging from \$250 to \$3,000 per job, per year for up to 10 years. Offshore Wind Tax Credit Program

Tax credits equal up to 100% of the qualified capital investments made, except as limited by a 110% net positive economic benefit to the State. The Offshore Wind Tax Credit is a financial tool designed to spur private capital investment and employment growth in major, land-based offshore wind industry projects. The tax credit program provides reimbursement for capital investments in industry-specific facilities.
